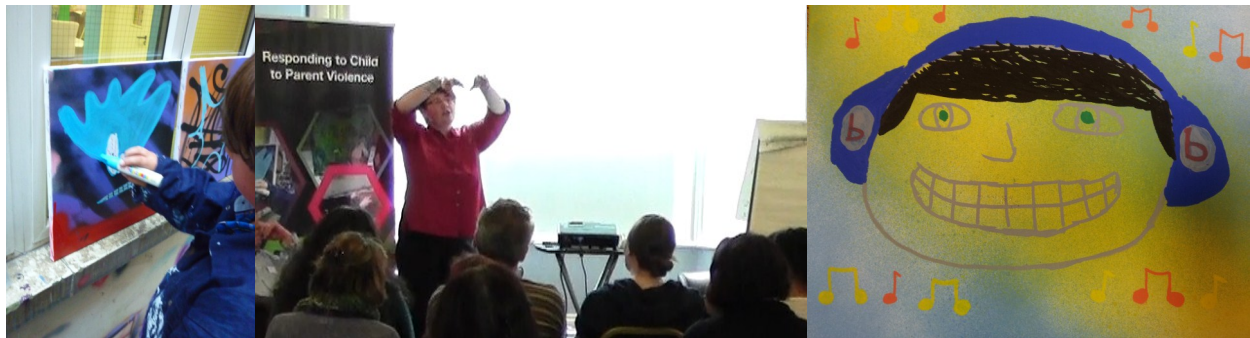


Responding to Child to Parent Violence

Child to parent violence: “...any harmful act by a child intended to gain power and control over a parent. The abuse can be physical, psychological, or financial.” Cottrell (2003)

The Project will:

- Raise **awareness** of how young people can be abusive and violent to their parents or carers
- Bring **knowledge and confidence** to practitioners through training and peer learning
- Research the **effectiveness** of **intervention** models across 5 European countries – **Bulgaria, England, Ireland, Spain and Sweden**
- Develop a **deeper understanding** of this complex issue
- **Demonstrate** how organisations can **work with young people** on child to parent violence
